- To place the student at the centre of the education journey and equip them with the tools and skills required to successfully navigate their senior years and life beyond.




OUR EDUCATIONAL MISSION

- 1. Achieving deep learning and personal best: Ensuring that all students are supported to achieve academic excellence in their subjects. Without deep learning and mastery of subject content and global competency, students will not have the courage to take risks, be agile or demonstrate with confidence the skills needed to meet the challenges of a dynamic and complex world.
- **2. Applying the learning:** Providing inter-disciplinary units of work and tasks that require students to connect and apply deep learning across disciplines using design thinking and inquiry-learning to tackle complex and real-world problems.
- **3. Owning the learning:** Supporting students to have the courage and confidence to take responsibility for their learning by setting goals, tracking progress and reflecting on their strengths and areas for improvement.
- **4. Co-designing the learning:** Enabling students to have a voice and choice in their learning and a strong sense of purpose by becoming co-designers of learning.
- **5. Curating and sharing the learning:** Supporting students to enrich, curate, celebrate and showcase learning.
- **6. Connecting the learning:** Committing to a greater emphasis on forging local, national and global connections and partnerships with students in other countries, universities and industries.
- **7. Sharing the learning:** Providing opportunities for students to work collaboratively in and beyond school to enrich the learning and tackle challenging real-world problems.

Knox Total Fitness adopts the principles of Positive Psychology and works to build the resilience and wellbeing of every child at Knox.

There are four key pillars of Knox Total Fitness: academic fitness, social and emotional fitness, spiritual fitness and physical fitness.

Knox Total Fitness aims to:

- Equip students with the skills, dispositions and habits required to thrive, be more resilient and live a virtuous life.
- Develop in each student a sense of purpose, engagement and accomplishment across all facets of their Knox experience through positive relationships with staff and their peers.
- Proactively support and develop the wellbeing of the individual and the whole community.
- Provide developmentally appropriate, research informed, meaningful programs and experiences across each of the domains of Total Knox Fitness for each child



What are the key elements of Knox Total Fitness?

- Knox Total Fitness is delivered through age-appropriate, context specific programs across the breadth of activities on offer at Knox, both inside and outside the classroom.
- Coaching and mentorship sit at the heart of the program, with each student supported by a teacher (Prep) or mentor (Senior School) who has received expert training in Positive Psychology, coaching and wellbeing.
- Students are introduced to activities and exercises scientifically proven to increase levels of wellbeing and performance. A team of specialist wellbeing staff, from the Knox teaching and psychology teams, design and implement evidence-informed wellbeing experiences.
- Every staff member at Knox, including teachers, coaches and support staff, receive training in Positive Psychology and Knox Total Fitness.
- When required, expert guidance and practical, positive interventions are provided for students.
- To share our knowledge, Knox will establish a research institute, and continue to develop partnerships with world-leading research, wellbeing and Positive Psychology institutions.

The Knox Learner Protocols frame expectations for students, teachers and parents about the expected learning environment at Knox, ensuring every student can reach their potential.


- Mindset: Fully engaging with the academic community with the knowledge that ability and competence grow with effort
- Behaviours: Developing positive learning habits that are consistently applied during independent and interdependent learning experiences
- Social skills: Collaborating with peers in a respectful, cooperative and empathetic manner towards the common goal of maximising learning
- Perseverance: Persisting in learning, withstanding challenges and setbacks, whilst knowing academic outcomes improve through self-disciplined and sustained application
- Learning Strategies: Using processes which positively influence learning, thinking and remembering



We are committed to enabling young people to develop the skills they need to achieve academic excellence in the innovation age. We plan for our students to enter the world with the skills, deep knowledge, mindset and dispositions that will enable them to flourish as informed, confident and courageous global citizens.

The key elements of Student Excellence are:

- **Global competency:** Demonstrating the competencies of creativity, critical thinking, collaboration, communication, character and citizenship.
- **Deep learning:** Deep discipline-based understanding that enables students to conceptualise, synthesise, make meaningful connections and develop insights into the process of learning
- Growth mindset: Belief in the capacity to grow and learn from successes, failures and feedback.
- Altruism: Caring for and honouring others through selfless acts of kindness and compassion.
- Agency and agility: Developing a flexible, adaptive mindset that applies learning to new and challenging contexts.

TEACHER EXCELLENCE

Educational research indicates that attributes of the teacher and the pedagogical strategies they deploy have a significant effect on student learning. The Knox vision is to develop highly skilled and innovative teachers who are passionate about their discipline and student learning. Staff excellence is a strategic intent of the School and we focus on building collective teacher efficacy in a collaborative environment.

To ensure that our teachers flourish as educators, Knox has invested in the establishment of the Research Institute of Innovation and Professional Learning (RiiPL) that ensures the:

- Delivery of quality professional learning and exemplary aspiring leadership programs
- Fostering of mutually beneficial partnerships with cross-sectoral schools
- Continuation of a research partnership with the University of Newcastle that enables our teachers to engage in further study



By investing in programs to improve and enhance our teachers' practice, we are ensuring each student has the opportunity to thrive and reach their academic potential.

The key elements of teacher excellence are:


- Knowing our students' stories: Intentional pedagogical practice that is learner centred
